<b>Collecting information when applying for a career</b>	Processing your application when applying for a career through the Website.	Full name, phone number, email address and further information included in the CV.
<b>Use of cookies on the Website</b>	Facilitate a Website feature that the user specifically requested, Analyze the Website usage to evaluate and improve its performance, improve user experience on the Website, inform and serve personalized ads more relevant to user interests.	IP address from which you access the Website, time and date of access, type of device and browser used, language used, links clicked via a mouse or a touch screen, and actions taken while using the Website.
